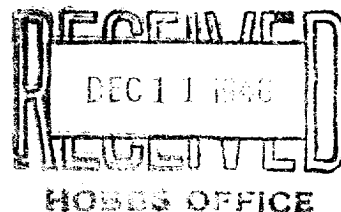

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3755' Plugged back depth, Cemented with 550 Sacks Common Cement and when plug was pumped to 600' got returns on 8 5/8" Braden Head and closed Braden Head, and pumped plug to 1600' and waited 20 minutes and pressure when started up was 600#, pumped to 1800' waited 15 minutes was 700#, pumped to 2000' waited 30 minutes was 800#, pumped to 2200' waited 15 minutes was 800# and pumped plug to 2356' with 1000# pressure at 12:15PM December 2, 1946.
