

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED 3755' Flugged back depth, drilled out cement and tested 6 5/8" Casing with 1610# for 40 minutes and lost 25% due to leaks in 2" Connections, drilled out Retainer at 3755 and ran 22" BUE 6.5# Tubing and 6 5/8" x 22" American Type G Control Head packer and set Facker at 3750' and Tubing at 3910', On December 6, swabbed 7AM to 7AM and swabbed 34.97 Bbls oil 69.56 water. On December 7, 1946, Spotted 6 gallons of Jelly Seal on bottom (3915') and acidized with 1000 Gallons of Dowell XX Acid went in under vacuum and at end of 222 barrels flush tubing pressure was 75#, Unseated packed and displaced sout oil behind 6 5/8" Casing with 145 Barrels of Sweet oil.
