3915' Total depth line, Pulled out 1" Tubing and 2 1/2" Tubing and American Type G Control Head Packer, and set Baker Model K Cement Retainer as a bridging plug at 3755' and dumped 2 sacks common cement on top with bailer, Ran Baker Retrievable Cement Retainer testing for holes in pipe and set at 2000'-2125'-2250'-2275' and circulated with 900# Pressure, set at 2400' and hole above, set at 3290' hole above, set at 2384' no hole above, smaller hole between 2384 and 2389', Set at 2498'-2523'-2624' 2649' 2749' and circulated with 900# Pressure, set at 2774' & 2767' and held 1400# Pressure, circulated at 2764'

Hole is at 2766'
