

Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3915' in Broken lime. 2 1/2" Upset tubing was set at 3900'. Well was swabbed and made approximately 5 bbls oil per hour.

The well was then acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid went in at start under 700# on tubing and 1000# on casing. Finished up w/ 550# on tubing and 850# on casing. Set 6 hours. Swabbed in and flowed 251 barrels of clean oil on 8-1/2 hour test. Hourly average of 30 barrels. Flowing through 1" open choke. Daily gas rate of 309,000. Gas oil ratio of 538.
