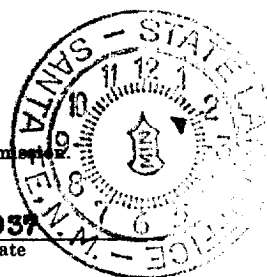

DUPLICATE

This well was drilled to the Total depth of 3912'. Ran 2 1/2" upset tubing and set at 3894'. Swabbed approximately 5 bbls oil per hour.

Acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid started in under Vacuum on tubing and 300# on casing. Finished up w/ 440# on tubing and 900# on casing. 32 barrels of flush oil went in under 200# on casing and tubing. Set 6 hours. Swabbed in and flowed 589 barrels clean oil on 16 1/2 hour test. Hourly average of 35 barrels. Flowing thru 1" open choke for 15 hours and 46/64" choke for 1 1/2 hours of the 16 1/2 hour test. Daily gas rate of 802,000. gas oil ratio of 1671. Tubing pressure 150#. Casing pressure 300#.
