Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3902'. 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3888'. Swabbed in and made 2 1/2 barrels oil per hour.

Treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid started in under 2300# on tubing and 1600# on casing. Finished under 1150# on tubing and 1450# on casing. 27 barrels of flush oil finished under 1200# on tubing and casing. Set 6 hours. Swabbed in and flowed into pits for 1 1/2 hours. Turned into tanks and flowed 359 barrels of pipe line oil on 15 hour test. Through 1" open choke on 2 1/2" upset tubing. Daily gas rate of 326,000 the last hour. Gas oil ratio of 715.
