Well was swabbed and produced 10 barrels oil per hour for 12 hours on a swabbing test.

8/30/36. The well was treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid went in under Maximum of 1000# on tubing and 1400# on casing. Minimum of Vacuum on tubing and 400# on casing. Set 6 hours. Swabbed in and flowed a hourly average of 44 barrels oil, clean oil, with gas volume of 640,000. And gas oil ratio of 606.
