6-5/8" 20# 10-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 3794' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 100 sacks.

Casing and fittings will be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the cement will then be drilled out of the casing and the same test of 1200# pressure again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure the drilling will then be resumed.
