Total depth 3897' Lime. Move in rig up and test 7" casing. If casing is found to be in bad condition will run approximately 3850' of 5-1/2" and cement with approximately 500 sacks to surface. 5-1/2" casing will case off high gas. This well is penalized on account of high GOR. This job is being done to repair well and reduce high GOR. Will also acidize with approximately 2000 gal. acid.
