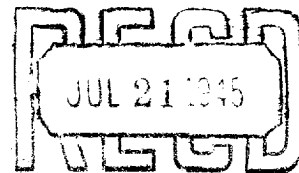

## MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the  
Tide Water Associated Oil Co. State "N" Well No. 1 in the

NW/4 of SW/4 of Sec. 32, T. 19S, R. 37E, N. M. P. M.,  
Eunice-Monument Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: Feb. 21 thru March 15 & on May 23, 1945

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing, ran bit to bottom, ran Dowell Electric Pilot Survey, plugged back with pea gravel and ran 143' of 5" 15# Liner set at 3862' and squeeze cemented with 43 sacks, 2100# pressure. Drilled out to 3899' and washed with 500 gals of Dowell X acid. On 5-23-1945 we treated with 2000 gals from 3868' to T. D. using Electric Pilot. On official test well flowed 40.52 bbls of oil and no water and Gas/Oil Ratio of 350 to 1. After two day shut in period the well flowed 110 bbls of oil in 36 hrs ending 6-4-1945.
