NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Our James H. William  
Well No. 1 in E/2 of Sec. 33, T. 19S, R. 37-E  
N. M. P. M., Monument Oil Field Lea County,  
on Dec. 18th 19 35. 15 1/2 in. 70 lb. casing was { cemented } in Red rock  
formation at a depth of 281 feet on December 16th, 19 35  
250 sacks of Common cement were used.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 281 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
