Pursuant to your letter of September 12, 1936, and our subsequent telephone conversation, we have prepared and enclose herewith in duplicate our standard form of casinghead gas purchase contract drawn to cover your fully owned leases above described.

The above leases lie in the Queen Sand Area east of our Mammoth gasoline plant and adjacent to our presently installed gathering system. The form of contract submitted is our standard form of agreement under which we are purchasing casinghead gas at this plant. Further in this connection we wish to specifically direct your attention to paragraph 26 which provides that we will not lay a residue return line to these properties at this time. Therefore, the agreement as drawn will cover only the surplus gas which you have available over and above that amount required by you on these leases for operational purposes.

If the enclosure is acceptable to you, will you please affix your witnessed signature thereto and return both copies to this office. After the contract has been signed by Warren as Buyer, a fully executed copy thereof will be furnished you for your permanent record.
