We have a copy of a letter in the file for the Cities Service Oil Company's State AR #1 2-20-37 from you to that company concerning their application for an NSP order on this well. In this letter you state that your office will withhold any action on this until further tests showed that this well should be classified as a gas well.

We have received a Form C-104 in this office today requesting a gas allowable on this well and reporting a Gas Oil Ratio of 110,500-1. The operator has requested that you issue this NSP on the basis of these tests, since connection has already been made to Permian Basin Pipeline Co.
