Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for the formation of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit for its State A-3 Unit No. 1 well located 1980 feet from South and 660 feet from East lines, of Section 3, T2OS, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont gas pool.

The Unit is proposed to consist of the SE/4 of Section 3, T20S, R37E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
- 2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership. New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Page 2

Continental's State Lease of Section 3, T2OS, R37E, described as the E/2 of the SE/4 has been communitized with Buffalo Oil Company's acreage described as the W/2 of the SE/4 of Section 3. T2OS, R37E, to form the requested 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the nonstandard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's State A-3 Unit No. 1 well as described above.
