In compliance with Rule 402, Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, effective January 1, 1950, the shut-in pressure of this well was found to be 1080#/sq. in. gage. This pressure was obtained after a shut-in period of one month. It was taken with a dead weight gauge. (This well was shut-in on March 2, 1951 at the request of the Warren Petroleum Corporation's Monument Gasoline Plant because it started making oil and was going sour. It has remained shut-in thereafter).
