## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was drilled to 3,898'. We then set 2" tubing on packer; this packer was set from 3,868' to 3,872' and well treated with 3,000 gals. of acid. The well responded by making approximately 30 bbls. of BS & water per day. We then called Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company and had their man pump in 20 sacks of cement in two stages; this cemented the tubing and packer in the hole and shut off the water. We then shot off the tubing at 3,780' and put well on production.
