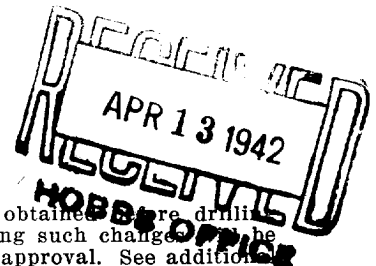

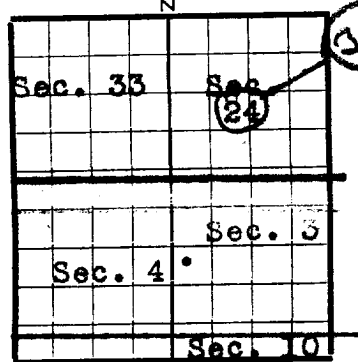

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Enclosed

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: SIZE OF HOLE, SIZE OF CASING, WEIGHT PER FOOT, NEW SET, DEPTH, LANDED OR CEMENTED, SACKS CEMENT. Row 1: 12 1/2", 10" 7", 22#, Yes New, 70' 3750 (Approx), Cemented, to surface - whatever is customary.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3800 feet.

Additional information:

7" O.D., pipe, if run in 9 5/8" hole must be cemented back to top of salt. Will take approximately 400 sacks.
