Re: Application to produce
Auerada L. S. Adkins No. 3 as
a Bradenhead Gas well in the
Cimarronool, San Juan County, New
Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Auerada Petroleum Corporation
wishes to state the following:

- (A) That Auerada L. S. Adkins No. 3, located in the NW/4
of the SW/4 of the SW/4 of section 5, T-20-, -37-,
San Juan County, New Mexico, was completed May 2, 1954, at
a plugged back depth of 5275 feet. The attached exhibit
A shows the location of this well together with the
location of all offset wells on the Auerada L. S. Adkins
lease.
- (B) That the subject well has 7" casing set at 3490 feet and
cemented with 100 sacks of cement. A 5" liner is set at
5714 feet and cemented with 175 sacks of cement. The
top of the liner is at 3642 feet. The attached exhibit
B is a schematic drawing of the casing program of the
subject well and shows the depth and size of each casing
string.
- (C) That the subject well is an oil well producing from the
perforated interval of 5178 to 5220 feet in the Addcock
zone, Cimarron Addcockool.
- (D) That the applicant proposes to produce the gas from the
Yates, Seven Rivers, and Queen zones from 3490 to 3399
feet, Cimarron Gasool, through the annulus of the 7 5/8"
and 7" casing strings and oil from the Addcock zone,
Cimarron Addcockool, through the tubing.
- (E) That the granting of this application for permission to
produce gas from the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen zones
and oil from the Addcock zone is in the interest of
conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
