The Cities Service Oil Company applied for a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit for its Laughlin No. 5, covering the SE/4 of Section 5, 208, 37E, in the Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, on November 17, 1954.

This increase in acreage comes about as a result of a gas operating agreement between Cities Service and the Sun Oil Company which was effective November 1, 1954. This agreement provides that the Sun Oil Company will have a 1/4 interest in Laughlin No. 5, which will now be permitted to drain 160 acres to include the Sun Oil Company Laughlin lease.

When this non-standard gas proration unit is approved, we would like to request that the 160 acre gas allowable be permitted from November 1, 1954, which was the effective date of the gas operating agreement.

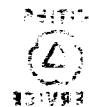
