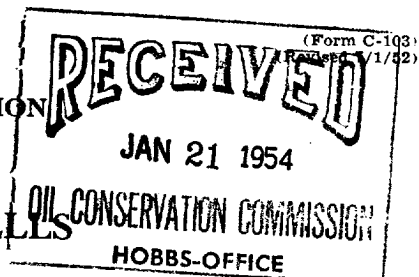

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was plugged back and recompleted as a single completion in the Queen zone by setting a Halliburton DM Bridge Plug at 4000' and spotting 15 sacks cement (124') on top of plug. A second bridge plug was set at 3375' and 2 sacks of cement (16') was dumped on top of plug. The new plugged back total depth is now 3359'.
