Re: Amonded application to dually complete Citles Service Oil Company's Laughlin No. 5, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By means of this amonded application, Cities Service Oil Company wishes to state the following:

- 1. That Cities Service Oil Company originally made application to dually complete Laughlin No. 5 in the SW/4 of SW/4 of SE/4 Section 5, T2OS, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico in such a manner as to produce oil from the Blinebry formation through the tubing, and gas from the Queen-Seven Rivers formation through the tubing-casing annulus. Permission to do this was granted by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by Administrative Order No. DC-4, effective July 28, 1953.
- 2. That the said well was drilled into the Blinebry formation to a total depth of 5743' and after thorough testing, the Blinebry formation was found to be non-commercial.
- 3. That the Cities Service Oil Company then contacted the Commission and obtained temporary approval to plug back, test the Paddock formation, and if found productive of oil, to make a dual completon with the Paddock formation producing oil through the tubing and the Queen-Seven Rivers producing gas through the annulus.
- 4. That the applicant has now dually completed said well to produce oil from the Paddock formation through the tubing, and gas from the Queen formation through the tubing-casing annulus in the following manner:
 - (a) Plugged back to 5224'.
 - (b) Perforated the 5¹/₂" casing from 5190 to 5215 opposite the Paddock formation.



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
