Gentlemen:

By means of this application, Cities Service Oil Company wishes to state the following:

1. That Cities Service Oil Company proposes to drill Laughlin No. 5 in SW/4 of SW/4 of SE/4 Section 5, T20S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, to an approximate total depth of 5725' to test the Blinbry Lime. If this zone is found to be productive, 5 1/2" production casing will be set and cemented back to the 8 5/8" casing.
2. That attached Exhibit "A" is a true copy of the Form 101, "Notice of Intention to Drill" for said well, which has been submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Hobbs, New Mexico.
3. That attached Exhibit "B" shows the location of said well, other wells on the same lease, and ownership and location of all the offset wells to Cities Service Oil Company's Laughlin Lease.
4. That if said well is completed in the Blinbry the applicant proposes to dually complete the well to produce oil from the Blinbry Formation through the tubing and gas from the Queen-Seven Rivers zone through the casing-tubing annulus in the following manner:
  - a. Perforate the 5 1/2" casing from approximately 3360' to 3460' opposite the Queen-Seven Rivers zone.
  - b. Set a production type packer below the casing perforations at approximately 5600'.That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is shown on the attached diagrammatic sketch marked Exhibit "C".
5. That in the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with oil from the Blinbry Formation and gas from the Queen-Seven Rivers zone is in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights.
