DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Laughlin #5 was drilled to a total depth of 2400' in line and anhydrite. Ran 2387.45' (58 Jts) of 8 5/8" OD 8h 24# and 28# J-55 and H-40 SS Casing set at 2398' and cemented with 925 sacks of which 625 sacks contained 4% gel and 300 sacks was neat on bottom. Cement circulated. Plug down at 10:00 AM 7/19/53. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Test was satisfactory and drilling resumed.
