DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Laughlin #5 was drilled to a total depth of 337' in red bed. Ran 318.82' (8 jts) of 13 3/8" 48# 8R S-40 SS Csg set at 335' and cemented with 330 sacks regular neat cement. Circulated out approximately 10 sacks. Plug down at 6:00 AM on 7-15-53. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure. Test was satisfactory and drilling was resumed.
