ket seal in bottom of hole. Treated with 2000 gallons Dowell EX acid,
October 20th, 1940. Reduced Gas/Oil Ratio to 4320:1. Increased produc-
tion from 45 to 144 bbls oil per day. Water increased from 50 to 145.
