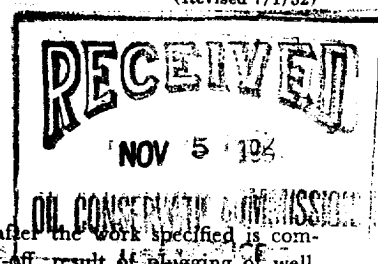

Total Depth 5755' Lime. P.B. 5649'. After setting Baker Model K cement retainer @ 5681', squeeze 25 sacks cement below retainer and 5 sacks on top of retainer to approximately 5649' and perforated 5-1/2" casing from 5535' to 5548' and tested. Results of test 400' of sulphur water in tubing.
