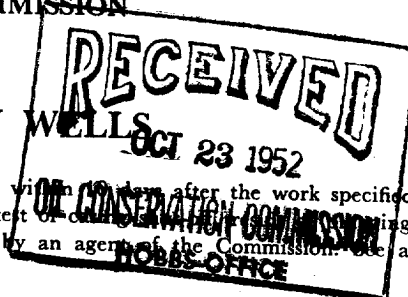

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 5755' Lime. Ran 181 joints of 5-1/2" OD 15.5# casing set @ 5752'. Two stage cement: first stage cemented w/335 sacks cement w/3% gel. Dropped DV bomb and opened ports of DV tool, cement circulated. Second stage w/200 sacks cement w/3% gel. Cement did not circulate. Cement set 48 hrs. Tested both stages w/1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Test ok.
