Gentlemen:

Attached is an Application for Multiple Completion for the subject well. To our knowledge the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission has not authorized the multiple completion of a well in these same zones within one mile of the subject well.

Gas production from the Queen Zone is dedicated to Northern Natural. Gas production from the Grayburg zone is not dedicated to a gas market at this time. Both zones are currently shut-in while waiting on a pipeline connection. The initial "Multipoint and one Point Back Pressure Test for Gas Well" will be taken when the gas pipeline connections are made. A packer leakage test will also be taken when the gas pipeline connections are made.

In support of this multiple completion, the following are filed:


1. Application for Multiple Completion (Form C-107)
