FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

8-5/8" 28# 8-thd. New Electric welded casing was set in this well at 2402' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 750 sacks of cement. 500 sacks through the casing and 250 sacks through the Bradenhead.

Casing and fittings will be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the cement plug will then be drilled out of casing and the same test of 1200# again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the drilling will then be resumed.
