We plan on pulling rods, pump and 3-1/2" OD EUE tubing and run 2-7/8" OD EUE tubing back in with a CI Retainer. We plan to set the CI Retainer at 3786' and squeeze open hole from 3792' to 3880' with 100 sacks and then perforate 6-5/8" OD casing from 3732' to 3783'. Swab well. It is our intention to shut-off water and increase oil production.
