DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3860' TB - Line

Finished drilling 7-7/8" hole to 3835' on 5-18-55. Ran 100 joints of 6-5/8" OD casing set at 3835' with 250 sacks of cement and 55 sacks of salt - 3798' at 4:15 PM, 5-18-55 with a maximum pressure of 800#. WGE 24 survey - tops of cement outside 6-5/8" OD casing at 1814' or 65.38' hit on 2" EUE Tbg. and tested 6-5/8" OD casing before and after drilling 1000 lbs. pressure - held OK. Drilled float collar, cement and shoe from 3798' to 3835' and drilled formation from 3835' to 3860'. Finished 5-3/4" hole to 3860' at 5:00 PM, 5-20-55. Continued with completion operations.
