DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well to a TD of 10,200'. 13-3/8" csg will be set at approximately 1050' and circulate cement to surface. 9-5/8" csg will be set between 4100' and 5000' and cemented with a calculated volume of cement that will bring cement to surface csg. 5-1/2" csg will be set at TD and cemented with a calculated volume of cement that will bring cement to bottom of 9-5/8" csg. We propose to drill to and test Ellenberger Zone and if productive will complete in same. If not productive in Ellenberger Zone well will be plugged back and completed in McKee Zone.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
