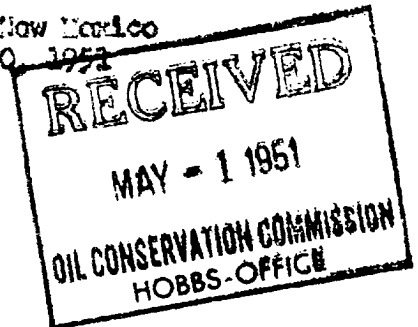

APPLICATION

COMES NOW Continental Oil Company, a Delaware Corporation,
operating in New Mexico from a field office in Hobbs, New Mexico, and
respectfully represents to the Oil Conservation Commission of the
State of New Mexico that it has completed the H. M. Britt A-6 No. 4
well, located 2130 feet from the South line and 510 feet from the
West line of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M.,
Lea County, New Mexico. This well was completed 11-20-50 for an
initial potential of 68 barrels of oil and 30 barrels of water produc-
ing from a perforated interval between 5206 feet and 5218 feet oppo-
site the Paddock formation.

In drilling this well, 7 5/8" intermediate casing was set
at 2500 feet and cemented with 677 sacks of cement. The top of the
cement behind this casing was determined by temperature survey to be
