DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

August 6, 1940 - Acidized with 500 gallons Dowell X Acid.

October 2, 1940 - Acidized with 1,000 gallons acid.

October 23, 1940 - 2" EUE x 4 1/2" Actual OD x 80" Rubber Robinson 3 in 1 HP gas packer (Only 60" or 3 rubbers on packer) set upside down at 3881', 4' of perforations immediately below packer.

Production before:- On state test on March 26, 1940 50 barrels oil in 24 hours thru 3/4" choke wide open with 686,868 cu. ft. gas GOR 13,834.

Production after:- On state test flowed 114 barrels oil and 20 barrels water in 24 hrs thru 2" tubing wide open, Company GAS 662,107 cu. ft. Title GOR 5,834.
