Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Gulf Oil Corporation G. C. Matthews No. 6, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, T-20-S, R-37-E, was completed November 26, 1951, at a plug back depth of 5724'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation G. C. Matthews Lease together with the location of all offset wells.

(b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 5769' and cemented with 650 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the perforated interval from 5665-5705' in the Monument-Blinebry Pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- (1) Perforate the 7" casing within the approximate interval of 3060-3350' in the Eumont Gas Pool. Top of Queen at 3060'.
- (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3700' to separate the two pay zones.
- (3) Produce the Monument-Blinebry Pool oil through the tubing and the Eumont gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Eumont and oil from the Monument-Blinebry is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
