DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 41 Jts (1803') 5-1/2" OD 15.50# Gr J-55 Hydrall SE casing liner. Set and cemented at 5249' with 150 sacks 4% Gel and 50 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug pumped to 5201'. Maximum pressure 1500#. Pulled setting tool and reversed out approximately 30 sacks cement. Job complete 9:15PM 7-9-54.

After waiting over 30 hours, ran 6-3/4" bit and Baker casing scraper to 3422' (top of cement). Drilled to top of liner at 3430'. Tested with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Ran 4-3/4" bit and casing scraper and drilled thru liner hanger from 3430-3450'. Ran bit to 5201' and drilled cement plug from 5201' to 5247'. Tested liner with 1000# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
