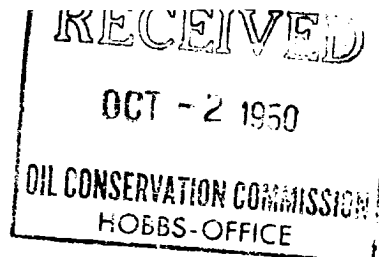

This well was completed May 12, 1936 with an initial Production test of 164 bbls. per hour. The well died suddenly on 8-1-50 & Swabbing tests indicated almost 100% water. We therefore desire to plug the well back from 3890 to 3847 with Cal-Seal & from 3847 to 3826 with Hydromite, & then put well back on Production from this open hole depth. (Present open hole depth 3800-3890).
