Gentlemen:

The Texas Company requests administrative approval of its application to dually complete its J. R. Phillips, Well No. 11 in the Monument (Ellenburger) Gas and Monument (McKee) Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of its application states the following:

- (1) The Texas Company is owner and operator of the J. R. Phillips Lease which comprises the NW/4, Section 6, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Attached is a plat showing the location of the J.R. Phillips, Well No. 11 on this lease. This well is located 738 feet from the West line and 736 feet from the North line of Section 6.
- (2) Attached is a diagrammatic sketch showing the proposed dual completion installation for this well indicating proposed tubing sizes, types of equipment, the formations involved and the approximate location of packer.
- (3) The Texas Company anticipates the completion of both the McKee and Ellenburger intervals in this well as gas producers. Thus, its application can be considered administratively under the provisions of Rule 112-A(c).
