Depth at start 3770 - Plugback depth at finish 3715

Set bridging plug @ 3754 and tested casing with 500#, perforated with 16 holes from 3740 to 3744, set retainer @ 3730 and squeezed with 100 sacks of cement. Let cement set 72 hours. Perforated casing w/4 jet shots per foot from 3710 to 3720. Snubbed dry. Acidized with 500 gallons of 15% regular acid. Flowed 60 barrels of oil and 189 barrels of water in 24 hours. Plugged back w/Weller jet gun to 3715. Set 2" UE tubing @ 3705. Flowed 42 Bbls. of oil and 178 barrels of water in 24 hours.
