DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to drill a well on the above described location to a total depth of approximately 5700 ft. in the Alimbury pay with the following casing and cementing program: Set 13 1/8" OD casing at 600 ft. and cement with sufficient amount of cement to circulate. Set 9 5/8" OD or 8 5/8" OD casing at approximately 1300 ft. and cement with sufficient amount of cement to circulate. Set 5 1/2" or 7" OD casing at approximately 5700 ft. and cement with 900 cu., perforate and acidize as necessary for production. If any difficulty should be encountered while drilling, making it necessary to alter the casing program, we will file a "Notice of Intention to Change Plans".

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
