- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
  - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5200 feet.
  - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed unit is located, and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit wall are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and Cities Service Oil Company to form the proposed non-standard gas prevention unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas prevention unit.
