DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 70 Jts (2855') of 9-5/8" 36# J-55 Casing with 3 Weatherford Centralizers and 12 Weatherford Scratchers from 2765' to 2898'. Set and cemented at 2900' with 1500 sacks 45 Gal Longhorn bulk cement and 100 sacks Lone Star on Bottom. Plug at 2855' - Maximum Pressure 1000#. Circulated approximately 10 sacks.

After waiting over 36 hours tested cement with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilling cement from 2855' to 2900' and tested with 500 psi for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
