**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Treated with 1000-gallons of Dowell X Acid, after running swab five times it started flowing, and at end of 24-hours it was flowing 78-bbls fluid per day, with 25% acid and water W/1,500,000 cu ft gas. After flowing two weeks it was making 70-bbls fluid per day W/19% sulphur water and 12-million cu ft gas. On December 14, 1938, pumped 4-sacks aquagel and 1-sack cotton seed hulls in casing above Packer, and shut well in for 24-hours, started flowing well through 1" choke on 12/15/38, and at this time (12/20/38) well is producing 85-bbls fluid per day W/17% water, and 350,000 cu ft gas, gas fluid ratio 4117.
