Following is a report giving the results of work done as indicated above at Capps
Well No. 31 in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 19S, R. 38E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs High Oil Field Lea County.

The plan outlined on Form SG X was followed except: Cemented 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 36# casing at 4025', using eighty sacks of Oil Max cement with the Halliburton method. The casing was cemented in line. The cement will be allowed to set for five days, after which time drilling will be resumed. There will not be a test of water shut-off as the hole is dry and in good condition.
