Following is a report giving the results of work done as indicated above at Cappa
Well No. 31 in S41 of Sec. 3, T. 19S, R. 38E
N. M. P. M., Hobbs High Oil Field Lea County.

The plan outlined on Form SG X was followed except: Cemented 10" 45# casing at 2798'8", using eighty sacks of Oil Max cement with the Halliburton method. The casing was cemented in anhydrite. The cement will be allowed to set for five days, after which time drilling will be resumed. There will be no test of water shut-off as the hole was dry and in good condition.
