


DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE GEOLOGIST
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector and approval obtained before drilling begins. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in triplicate. One copy will be returned following approval.

Dear Sir: You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as Byera Well No. 2 in NE of Sec. 3 T. 19S, R. 36E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Hobbs Oil Field, LeFlore County



The well is 1850 feet (S.) of N line and 2310 feet (W.) of East line of NE1 (Give location from section or other legal subdivision lines. Cross out wrong directions.)

If state land the oil and gas lease is No. Assignment No. If patented land the owner is Lea-Mex Development Co., Address Hobbs, New Mexico.

AREA 640 ACRES STATE WELL CORRECTLY The lessee is J. F. Cusack, Inc., Address Midland, Texas. The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3615 feet. We propose to drill well with No. Rotary Make of Drill

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated.

Table with 5 columns: Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented. Row 1: 10 1/2, 50 lb, New, 850, Cemented. Row 2: 7", 28 lb, New, 1100, Cemented.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 1100 feet. Additional information:
