NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Dyers  
Well No. 26 in NW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T. 19-S, R. 30-E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on May 16th. 1935 9" 34 lb. casing was 45-foot cemented in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 1885 feet on May 13th. 1935  
350 sacks of El Toro Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Dry feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
