## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 21, 1946 at 4:30 p.m., forty-eight (48) hours had elapsed since running 5½" OD 14# J-55 casing at 4210 in subject well and cementing with 650 sacks, to be used as oil string. Casing shutoff test was performed at the time mentioned in the following manner:

Pressure was built up to 1000# and held for 30 minutes, after which cement plug was drilled. A pressure of 1000# was again built up and held for 30 minutes. These tests were Ok and completion operations were resumed.
