Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

Drilling will be resumed after cement has been allowed to stand four days. In accordance with authority of State Inspector J. D. Hunter, no water shut-off test will be made.
