Additional information: Well to be drilled with rotary tools to an approximate total depth of

4350' and the casing program followed as outlined above. All work in connection with drilling and completion to conform to the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. A permeability profile survey will be run and special tests made to determine water producing zones. A 5" OD Liner will be set and cemented through the pay section to exclude water and the liner will be gun perforated into the oil bearing strata. This northward location is authorized by the
